MATERIAL TYPE



Paper

Newspapers, magazines, envelopes, office paper, junk mail, catalogues, brochures, wrapping paper, telephone directories



Cardboard

Cereal boxes, brown boxes, greetings cards



Glass

Jars and bottles



Cans

Food and drinks cans, aerosol cans



Plastic Bottles

Plastic milk bottles, water bottles, soft drinks bottles, shampoo/conditioner bottles, detergent bottles, washing up liquid bottles



Garden Waste

Grass cuttings, leaves, hedge clippings, prunings, twigs & small branches, - cut flowers, fallen fruit (windfalls), houseplants, dead plants, straw/hay, rabbit bedding.



Textiles

Clothing (adult and children's), bedding and curtains, paired shoes, handbags and belts



WHICH CONTAINER

Green box with **Yellow** lid



Use your own **Cardboard** box or **Green** box - no lid.



Brown bin*



Green bin**



Red sack



USEFUL TIPS

Paper – Please ensure you keep the paper dry by using the yellow lid. **No cardboard** – use a separate green box with no lid or use your own cardboard box as below. If you need an extra green box, ring our helpline.

Cardboard – Please try to secure your cardboard to help prevent it blowing away in strong winds on collection day. Do not mix with paper in green box.

Glass – Remove lids/top. Rinsing reduces contamination and odour. Do not put any carrier bags into the brown bin.

Food/Drinks Cans – It helps to wash & squash. Aerosols - **DO NOT** pierce or squash.

Plastic Bottles – We do not take anything other than plastic bottles, i.e. no tubs, pots or bags. Remove lids/tops. Lids must be closed on bins or we cannot empty them.

Garden Waste - Lids must be closed on bins or we cannot empty them. No soil, stones, rubble or food waste. **No plastic bags.** Should you require an extra green bin, please contact our helpline.

Textiles DO NOT put your red sack in the green box. Textile Collection Helpline - **0161 736 8090**

Please ensure you put all recycling out by 7.30am on collection day. As rounds have changed, your usual collection time may change. Recycling should be put out at the same place as you put your refuse.

* In some areas where there are access or location problems, we are not able to provide a brown bin so green boxes are provided as an alternative. Some properties may have a collection point just for their brown bins.
