4350	Co Cllr Wakeford has sent 3 letters and has not yet received a reply. It was suggested that if Higham Parish Council applied for the planning and it was approved it could be used as a joint school/village car park (a possibility that would need to be investigated further but could be a fall back plan), or a change of greenbelt may be proposed in the future. At present awaiting a response from the planning office.	
4351	 Clerk's Report and Correspondence The clerk's report was distributed before the meeting. 	
4352	 County Councillor's Report The grass verge cutting is confirmed as imminent. Goldshaw Booth Parish Council meeting raised the subject of speeding. They are looking at contacting surrounding villages to invest (jointly) in a speed indicator device; with a subsidy from County Council. The spid will be passed from village to village with a specified time period of use. 	HPC are in favour of the idea – add speeding back on to the agenda.
4353	 Borough Councillor's Report There is talk of a reduction in Councillors. Wards (talk of) are to be increased thereby reducing Councillors. Towns / Parishes with parks are being asked to take on ownership of the park. Higham Parish Council owns all our park equipment. 	
4354	Refurbishment of Sheds on Playing Fields Cllr Forrest has arranged the materials for the roof to be completed within the next week or so. Doors are not sorted as yet but should be soon. New trees next to the shed are looking good – thanks to Cllr Forrest for arranging these. A grant was received to purchase the new trees and extend the footpath (lengthsman).	
4355	Some progress has been made. Cllr Willoughby has spoken to Mr Wilson who has in turn spoken to the electric company. They accept that the cable has to be cut off under the tarmac and the area reinstated. A disconnection date of first week in August was given and remedial works, including a good quality top soil and reseeding, to be completed during the second week.
