1. Nomination Papers

2. Delivery of the Nomination Papers

Nomination papers must be delivered **by hand** to the Elections Office, Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire BB9 7LG, on any day after the date of this notice Monday to Thursday 9.00 am to 5.00 pm and Friday 9.00 am to 4.45 pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4 pm on Wednesday, 3rd April 2019.

3. Poll

If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 2nd May 2019.

4. Registration

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12.00 midnight on Friday, 12th April 2019. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.

5. Absent Votes

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire, BB9 7LG by 5 pm on Monday, 15th April 2019.

Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire, BB9 7LG by 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire, BB9 7LG by 5 pm on Thursday, 2nd May 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019.
